The Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is seeking public comment on the feasibility study (FS) report and proposed plan for the Mission Wye state superfund facility (Facility) located 5 miles outside of the Livingston city center. The FS report includes possible cleanup options and the proposed plan identifies DEQ's preferred final remedy for completing cleanup activities at the Facility. DEQ is planning to hold a public meeting in the City-County Complex at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 19, 2019. After a brief presentation and question and answer period, DEQ will accept and record verbal comments on the FS report and proposed plan. The public comment period for the both documents begins on June 6, 2019, and ends at 11:59 pm MDT on July 6, 2019.
