

Youth Sports Indoor Practices and Games (Basketball & Other Indoor Sports)

The safety of our participants, coaches, and families is our top priority. The following policy outlines how the Livingston Recreation Department will handle winter weather-related cancellations for indoor youth sports practices and games, including basketball.

1. School Closures & Early Dismissals

• If Livingston School District (or the majority of other area schools) cancels school or dismisses early due to inclement weather, all youth sports indoor practices will be canceled for that day.

2. Evening & Weekend Weather Conditions

- If hazardous weather develops later in the day or over the weekend, the Recreation Department will assess conditions and determine cancellations based on:
 - Road conditions and travel advisories from the National Weather Service and local authorities.
 - Facility conditions, including heating and accessibility.
 - School district or city facility closures.
- A decision regarding evening practices will be made by 3:00 PM on weekdays and by 6:30 AM for weekend activities.

3. Notification of Cancellations

- Cancellations will be announced via:
 - Livingston Recreation Department Facebook page
 - City of Livingston website
 - Email notifications to participants and coaches from CivicRec
 - Text alerts (if applicable)

4. Makeup Events

 Makeup events will be considered but are unlikely due to limited indoor facility space and scheduling constraints.

5. Personal Safety

• Families should always use their discretion when deciding whether to attend a scheduled practice during winter conditions. If conditions are unsafe in your area, please notify your coach.
